Dear Owner:

The Division of Housing Code, acting under Chapter 254-27A(1)(c), directs that between October 1 and December 1, each year, a licensed plumber, licensed heating contractor or an employee of a gas utility company must conduct an inspection of the above mentioned building's heating facilities.

The inspection shall include such tests and visual inspections necessary to determine whether there is any defective equipment or unsafe conditions present.

A copy of this inspection report must be filed at my office by December 1 of this year. Failure to act will result in a summons being issued against the owner of record. The summons will be processed for municipal court where a fine of \$1,250.00 or a 90-day jail sentence can be imposed.
