COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT – PUBLIC SERVICES SUMMER YOUTH PROGRAMS

The City of Jersey City is accepting applications for a targeted Community Development Block Grant – Public Services (CDBG-PS) Summer Youth Program. The purpose of this Request For Proposals (RFPs) is to obtain proposals from non-profit entities interested in participating in the City's CDBG-PS Program to provide eligible activities as noted below.

Approximately \$70,000 is available for youth programs that will have a measureable impact on youth during the summer months.

The City will target this funding for the following eligible activities:

Eligible Activity	Use
Summer Youth Recreation	Projects that involve low-income youth in summer recreational activities (i.e., soccer, basketball, dance and music programs...). Recreation activities are for programs not currently funded by the City.
Youth Development Program	Projects that provide academic enrichment, financial literacy and programs designed to prevent or reduce youth crime.
