## EXECUTIVE ORDER OF THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF JERSEY CITY

### EXECUTIVE ORDER OF THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF JERSEY CITY ESTABLISHING A ONE-TIME BENEFIT FOR THE POLICE CHIEF

Pursuant to the Faulkner Act, NJSA 40:69A-43, amended, the Mayor is authorized to set the salaries, wages or other compensation of all employees of administrative departments, except department directors and employees whose salaries are required to be fixed by ordinance.

Pursuant to E.O. 04-005, an appointed Chief of Police who retires under the PFRS from the position of Chief of Police, without returning to membership in the P.S.O.A. prior to retirement, and without having previously received payment under the P.S.O.A. labor agreement for terminal leave benefits, receives terminal leave benefits upon retirement as Chief of Police in accordance with the applicable provisions of the P.S.O.A. labor agreement based upon the amount of terminal leave that had accrued prior to his or her appointment to the Chief of Police position. Terminal leave is paid to a retiring Chief of Police at the rate of pay, including longevity, in effect as of the date of retirement from the position of Chief of Police, based upon the formula for staff personnel then in effect under the P.S.O.A. labor agreement for Police Superior Officers.

Pursuant to my authority as Mayor, I issue the following executive Order:

The Police Chief, may elect to receive a payment of no more than \$15,000 for compensatory days and vacation days he accrued prior to his appointment as Chief of Police. He shall be paid at the rate of pay for a lieutenant, in effect under the 2006-2008 P.S.O.A. labor agreement, including longevity.

The number of compensatory days and vacation days and any compensation otherwise due therefore, shall be deducted from any terminal leave due, as of the date of his retirement.

This Order shall be effective immediately and expire on June 30, 2010. The City Clerk, the Business Administrator and each Department Director shall post a copy of this Executive Order in a conspicuous place, provide a copy to any employee upon request and maintain a copy in their files.
