RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE CITY OF JERSEY CITY'S APPLICATION TO THE GOOGLE FIBER FOR COMMUNITIES PROGRAM

COUNCIL OFFERED AND MOVED ADOPTION OF THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION:

WHEREAS, Google plans to test ultra-high speed broadband networks in one or more trial locations across the country; and

WHEREAS, the Google fiber networks will deliver internet speeds of over 1 gigabit per second, which is more than 100 times faster than what most Americans have access to today; and

WHEREAS, Google plans to offer service at a competitive price to at least 50,000 and potentially up to 500,000 people; and

WHEREAS, by virtue of its relatively small geographic size, its population density, its population diversity, the presence of major financial entities, and the sheer inventiveness and creativity of its residents, the City of Jersey City can provide Google a high probability of success; and

WHEREAS, the deadline for submitting an application to the program is March 26, 2010;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Municipal Council of the City of Jersey City affirms its support for the City of Jersey City's application to the Google Fiber for Communities Program.
