The City of Jersey City is scheduled to receive approximately \$5,450,102 in CDBG funding; \$386,055 in ESG funding; \$2,810,245 in HOPWA funding; and \$1,452,311 in HOME funding from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for the 2014 program year. **Proposal application packets for CDBG, ESG, HOPWA and HOME will be available beginning September 13, 2013. As part of the Consolidated Plan, the City of Jersey City has established priorities for Housing, Social Services, Public Facilities, Homeless / Special Needs Population, Infrastructure and Economic Development needs. These priorities are listed in the application packet that will be available on September 13, 2013. Applicants are encouraged to obtain applications from the City's website.
