**PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES**


No person shall park a vehicle any of the streets or parts thereof described.



# ORDINANCE OF JERSEY CITY, N.J.

COUNCIL AS A WHOLE  
offered and moved adoption of the following ordinance:

CITY ORDINANCE 11-069

**TITLE: ORDINANCE DEDICATING THAT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF MONTGOMERY STREET  
AND BRUNSWICK STREET BE ALSO KNOWN AS MONSIGNOR KELLY WAY**

**Whereas,** Martin Robert Kelly was born in New York City on September 22, 1921. He was the second son born to the late Lillian and Thomas E. Kelly Sr. He graduated from St. Cecilia High School in Englewood, New Jersey and Seton Hall University; and

**Whereas,** Martin Robert Kelly was ordained in 1947 from Immaculate Conception Seminary in Darlington, New Jersey. His service to God, the Catholic Church, and the community was tireless; and

**Whereas,** Monsignor Martin Robert Kelly's first assignment was at St Bridget Church in Newark, New Jersey. In 1953, he was assigned to St Catherine Parish in Glenn Rock, N.J. where he served until 1960 and;

**Whereas,** Monsignor Kelly volunteered for the mission in Santa Cruz, Bolivia, where he founded the Parish of Saint Joseph the Worker and served the people as their pastor until 1967 and ;

**Whereas,** Monsignor Kelly returned to the United States, where his next assignment was as Parochial Vicar of Saint Bridget Church, Jersey City where he worked in particular with the emerging Hispanic community; and

**Whereas,** Monsignor Kelly later became the Pastor of Saint Bridget in Jersey City. As Pastor, he was actively involved in the renovation of Saint Bridget School. Through his own personal sacrifices and his astute administration skills, the school survived amidst very trying times and ;

**Whereas,** Monsignor Kelly relocated to St. Aloysius Church in Jersey City to "retire" in 1990. However, his ministry to the Hispanic community continued until he "officially" retired and moved to St. Joseph Home for the Elderly in Totowa, N.J. in 2008.

**Whereas,** Monsignor Martin Robert Kelly entered into eternal life on February 2, 2011. He was predeceased by two brothers, Thomas E. Kelly Jr., Gerard Donald Kelly and his wife, Ruth. He is survived by his sister, Eileen Kelly; his sister-in-law, Margaret E. Kelly, and 13 nieces and nephews.

**Now, Therefore, Be it Ordained,** that the Municipal Council of the City of Jersey City deems it fitting and appropriate to honor the memory of Monsignor Martin Robert Kelly by dedicating that the northeast corner of Montgomery Street and Brunswick Street also be known as Monsignor Martin Robert Kelly Way.

- A. All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
- B. This ordinance shall be a part of the Jersey City Code as though codified and fully set forth therein. The City shall have this ordinance codified and incorporated in the official copies of the Jersey City Code.
- C. This ordinance shall take effect at the time and in the manner as provided by law.
- D. The City Clerk and the Corporation Counsel be and they are hereby authorized and directed to change any chapter numbers, article numbers and section numbers in the event that the codification of this ordinance reveals that there is a conflict between those numbers and the existing code, in order to avoid confusion and possible accidental repealers of existing provisions.
