

## NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Sealed proposals will be received, and opened by the Director of Purchasing at One Journal Square Plaza 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor Jersey City, New Jersey 07306 on **August 1, 2013 at 11:00 am** for the **Jersey City Signalization Project No. 11-016**, in the City of Jersey City.

This is a federally funded project. This project involves the supply and replacement of LED Traffic Signal Modules citywide and the supply and installation of video detection cameras at selected intersections, complete with cable, consoles and other peripherals to make the system operational. Cost of the removal of existing loop lead shall be included in the price. The video detection cameras could be a 1, 2, 3 or 4 camera system.

Bids may be submitted in person, or may be sent by U.S. certified mail return receipt requested, or may be sent by private courier service. Mail bids to: Peter Folgado, Director, City of Jersey City Division of Purchasing, One Journal Square Plaza, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, Jersey City, New Jersey 07306. Bids sent by mail must be received by the Director of Purchasing no later than 4:00 P.M. of the last City business day before the day of the bid reception. Bids sent by courier service must be delivered to the Director no later than 11:00 AM on the day of the bid reception. The City shall not be responsible for the loss, non-delivery or physical condition of bids sent by mail or courier service. Bids must be submitted individually in a sealed envelope addressed to the Director. Bid Proposal must comply with specifications.

Bidders are required to comply with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et. seq. and N.J.A.C. 17:27 et. seq. (Equal Employment Opportunity/Affirmative Action Program). Bidders are also required to comply with the provisions of P.L. 2004, c.57, which includes the requirement that contractors provide copies of their Business Registration Certificates issued by the New Jersey Department of the Treasury. These provisions are incorporated herein by Reference. Full Requirements of the program may be obtained with Proposal Forms.

Bid Proposals **MUST BE ACCOMPANIED** by a Bid Bond or Certified Check, made payable to the City of Jersey City, in an amount equal to Ten (10%) percent of the Total Bid Price; but not more than Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) nor less than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00).

The Director of Purchasing reserves the right to reject any and all bids received, or portions thereof, if deemed to be in the interest of the City to do so.
