Mayor Healy to Raise Dominican Flag Over City Hall In Celebration of 167 Years of Independence

JERSEY CITY – Mayor Jerramiah T. Healy, members of the Municipal Council, and the Department of Health & Human Services, Division of Cultural Affairs will raise the Dominican flag over City Hall at 4:00 p.m. on Friday, February 25, 2011, 280 Grove Street.

“The Dominican community continues to make outstanding accomplishments to our city every day,” said **Mayor Healy**. “In raising their flag alongside the American flag we are celebrating not only the triumphs of Dominican-Americans, but also the incredible impact that they have made on Jersey City.”

The **Dominican Republic** occupies the eastern two-thirds of the island of Hispaniola, in the Greater Antilles. Originally explored and claimed by Christopher Columbus on his first voyage in 1492, the island of Hispaniola became a springboard for Spanish conquest of the Caribbean and the American mainland. In 1697, Spain recognized French dominion over the western third of the island, which in 1804 became Haiti. The remainder of the island, by then known as Santo Domingo, sought to gain its own independence in 1821, but was conquered and ruled by the Haitians for 22 years. In February 1844, the country finally attained independence as the Dominican Republic in 1844 and is celebrated on February 27th of each year.
